Frequently Asked Questions



Join us as we take Steps to a Brighter Future by participating in the Wendy's Walk for Kids! Our goal is to raise \$200,000 to be distributed in equal amounts to: *The Dave Thomas Foundation for Adoption, Make-A-Wish Foundation of Central NY, Broome County YMCA and Catholic Charities of Broome County.*

Who Can Register? EVERYONE! Adults, children, individuals, families, co-workers, clubs, teams, organizations, schoolmates and friends – all are welcome!

How Do I Register? You can register on-line at www.wendyswalk.com. Or, you can pick up a registration form and pledge sheet at area Wendy's Restaurants. Complete the Registration Form and submit it, along with your \$10.00 registration fee (18 years or older) and pledges during one of two registration times: Saturday, August 18, 2012, 9:00am-5:00pm at Dick's Sporting Goods Open (En-Joie Golf Course) or at the Walk on Sunday, August 19, 2012, 9:00am-4:00pm.

When Do I Walk? Teams will gather at the 1st and 10th tees at 4:45pm on Sunday, August 19th. The 2-mile walk will begin at 5:00pm.

Is There a Cost to Enter the Open on August 19th? Admission to the Dick's Sporting Goods Open is FREE to registered walk participants on Sunday, August 19, 2012.

Is There a Cost to Enter the Wendy's Walk for Kids? There is a \$10.00 registration fee for walkers 18 years and older. Walkers receive a Wendy's Walk for Kids t-shirt (while supplies last). Kids 17 and under walk for free and also receive a Wendy's Walk for Kids t-shirt (while supplies last).

Is There A Required Amount of Money I Must Raise? No. All participants are asked to raise as much as they can to help these four most worthy charities. We recommend each participant raise \$100 (10 people donating \$10 each).

How Do I Collect Money, and Where Do I Send It?

- 3) Money should be turned in at the Wendy's Walk for Kids registration table on Sunday, August 19th, 9:00am-4:00pm at the Dick's Sporting Goods Open.
